#### 4. CWPCA UPDATE

Jim Mogan presented an update on the third and final year of the first 3 year audit cycle for CWPCA. Highlights include:

- 17 external audits completed to date in 2010
- Major issues include venting into the workplace, alarms, documentation and training.
- Internal auditor training session in Calgary on Nov.8<sup>th</sup> 2010
- Web based internal auditor training will start in 2011

#### CWPCA REGULATIONS

Howard Pruden presented the work of the CWPCA Steering Committee, which revised the regulations as well as the ACQ/CA TRD's for the next three year cycle.

This review is the result of a directive from the membership to reflect the lower risk associated with non-CEPA toxic preservatives.

Changes were made to three aspects of the program;

- 1. CWPCA Regulation Changes Non-CEPA toxic preservatives
- 2. Scoring Changes Non-CEPA toxic preservatives
- 3. Worksheet Changes
- 4. Plant "Must Have" List At the time of audit

The complete presentation on the CWPCA Regulations update is attached for your reference.

H. Walthert has been in discussions with Environment Canada regarding revisions to the TRD. EnCan envisions a generic TRD for all preservatives with references to chemical specific requirements. Any revisions need to be justified. EnCan has indicated a desire to complete the work by end of March 2011.

#### 6. PMRA UPDATE

Henry Walthert gave members an update on the activities of the Pest Management Regulatory Agency, specifically the re-evaluation of heavy duty wood preservatives and the issuance of the Proposed Re-evaluation Decision Document (PRVD) posted on August 20<sup>th</sup> 2010. Public comment for the PRVD closed on October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010, to be reviewed and resolved by PMRA. Following that, the agency will issue the final version of the document to the public.

WPC estimates that the re-evaluation process will be final and completed in approximately one year.

#### 7. SUSTAINABILITY COALITION

Henry Walthert updated meeting delegates on the work of the sustainability coalition with the Canadian Wood Council and the Forest Products Association of Canada.

WPC supports strongly the Sustainability Coalition and is constantly present at the coalition meetings, represented by one of three following members:

- 1. Mary-Anne Dalkowski (Timber Specialties)
- 2. Henry Walthert (Wood Preservation Canada)
- 3. Michael Srogosz-Bolduc (Wood Preservation Canada)

Some of the tools developed by the coalition will be added to the WPC toolbox, developed by the WPC P&E Committee.
