5. CSA O80 Revisions

A lengthy discussion was conducted to explore the difficulties in launching the CLSAB quality assurance program. Five main issues arose.1) performance claims, 2) treatment levels, 3) application of commodities, 4) sampling of sapwood / heartwood and 5) accuracy of notice to code officials.

The committee agreed to explore the main areas in order to move forward on the quality assurance program.

- 1. Sampling of red pine as per AWPA
- 2. Alternate detailing above ground or ground contact CWC.
- 3. Collect data on in-situ performance. WPC to obtain proposals from organizations for sampling.
