1. CALL TO ORDER

Committee Chair T. Moryto called the meeting to order.

2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

3. ADOPTION OF MINUTES

Motion by P. Hattin to adopt the minutes of the previous meeting held April 6, 2009. Seconded by D. Anderson. CARRIED

4. CLSAB

H. Walthert reported on a meeting with the CLSAB Operations Committee held in Edmonton in September. J. Quantz attended with H. Walthert. The purpose of participation was to inform CLSAB of WPC's intent to develop an industry process standard and to request that their program be extended to include this new standard.

5. CSA O80 Revisions

Members discussed the difficulties in meeting CSA standards on a consistent basis. The WPC Board of Directors presented to the membership a draft "Industry Standard for Residential Products" that was prepared by a special working group of the Board consisting of treater and supplier members.

It was acknowledged that additional work would be required to fine tune the standard before it could be implemented. Concerns were raised that the standard was not in the CSA standard and therefore would not be applicable to building code requirements. The Chairman indicated that it was the intention of the Board to present the standard to the CSA technical committee for information at the upcoming CSA TC meeting.

After considerable discussion the Chairman asked that the entire WPC membership in attendance express their opinion on the standard through a vote. Associate members were excluded from the vote.

Motion by L. McTaggert to adopt the "Industry Standard" as presented. (Appendix 1) Seconded by L. Prendiville.

The motion carried by a affirmative vote of 15, negatives 1, and abstentions 2.

Members asked that a formal vote of the membership be completed to provide an opportunity for all members to voice their opinion on the standard. The Chairman agreed that a recommendation would go to the Board to conduct a formal letter ballot.
